Electronic entries should be emailed to Ed Ogawa at ed5ogawa@earthlink.net. Please include all information requested on the entry form. One file per image pair, side-by-side, left on left, right on right, no margins, no line down the middle, images will be re-sampled by the projectors. Maximum combined size of attachments should be less than 12MB per message.

Conditions of Entry:

1. The Exhibition is open to anyone; however, an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent in its reasonable discretion believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions.

2. Entries must be limited to not more than four images per section. Slides must be 'Realist-format' mounted (RBT mounts preferred). Prints accepted as 7-inch stereoscope cards. The title and maker's name should appear on the back. 3. Entries must originate as photographs (images-captures of objects via light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally. By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his own and permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and/or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. The exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright. For Electronic Imaging Section, images may be acquired on traditional film and scanned to an electronic file or acquired electronically. (Submission implies acceptance of all conditions).

4. Images may be altered, either electronically or otherwise, by the maker and artwork or computer graphics created by the entrant may be incorporated if the photographic content predominates.

5. All final work must be on photographic film or on photographic or electronic print material, mounting excepted (excluding electronic entries.)

6. Images previously accepted may not be reentered regardless of title.

7. An entrants four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging.

8. Selection will follow the current Photographic Society of America's (PSA)

Consolidated Exhibition Standards (CES) and PSA Uniform Judging Practices.

9. All entries must be sent prepaid with entry fee. Electronic entry payment should be mailed prior to closing date, email info to chairperson.

10. For slide & card entries: the title, the name of the maker must appear. View in which proper orientation is not obvious (e.g. abstracts) should be marked on the back as to which way is up. Slides should be spotted in the lower left corner 11. All accepted entries will be credited to the entrants at the showings and in the catalog. Names of accepted entrants will be submitted for listing credit in PSA's "Who's Who in Stereo Photography" and for Star Rating records.

12. Report cards will be emailed, unless a written copy is requested.

13. Domestic entries returned First Class Mail & foreign entries, Air Mail.

14. All possible care will be exercised in handling of all entries, but no responsibility is assumed for loss or damage of entries during the Exhibition or in transit.

Entry Fees & Charges – Electronic, Slides & Prints are three different competitions. The entry fee is US \$8 (US \$10 for entries from outside the USA). For special handling, please include instructions and funds for postage (heavy return items, will not be returned w/o significant postage. Send entries to respective Exhibition Chairperson at address listed. Make checks payable to SCSC, US currency will be accepted at entrant's risk. Entries for which fees have not been received by the selection date will not be judged, nor returned until receipt of sufficient funds to cover postage. Reports cards will be emailed, unless hard copy/postage included.
